Kids Art Contest Application

How to enter this free contest:

Artists will draw their artwork at their convenience prior to their submission on or before April 10th 2010. Each child can submit original works of art, in any style or medium. Applicants may submit multiple entries in the contest. Preferred sizes for the art work are 8.5" x 11".

Submissions should not be three-dimensional. Art supplies such as Colored pencils, crayons, colored markers, and paper will be provided by the Artists.

Artists must register and submit their works for the contest between March 10th and April 10th. Official entry forms will be available on Turant Website or it can be requested by email at any time. Artists must understand that if accepted, their entry will be published on Turant Web site at www.turant.org and original artwork will not be returned.

Judging and Notification:

Winning entries will be selected by a panel of judges from different School Teachers and Professionals. Entries will be judged according to the interpretation of the concept, creativity, use of color and overall composition. All winners will be announced and Awards ceremony will be held for the winners at the April 23rd 2010 International Kids' Festival. All entries will be exhibited during the celebrations.
